**Target Group** All Seafarers

**Contents** This learning opportunity is designed for Deck Officers, Engineering Officers and Ratings for sea-going operations as well as those restricted to port operations only.

**Objectives** Requirement for all persons wishing to pursue a career at sea and/or who need to remain in-date/current against this competence.

### **Outline**

- Minimize the risk of fire and maintain a state of readiness to respond to any emergency situations involving fire;
- Fight and Extinguish Fires;
- Control firefighting operations onboard a ship;
- Organize and train fire parties;
- Investigate and compile reports on incidents involving shipboard fires; and
- Inspect and service fire-detection/suppression systems and firefighting equipment.

**Prerequisite** ABET literacy  
Be medically fit for sea.

**Duration** 3 days

### **Completion Exit level:**

The competent learner will be able to perform the role a firefighting crew member onboard a Vessel or platform both at sea and alongside.

**Assessment:** Written assessment & practical evaluation.
